Liver disease symptoms vary, depending on the underlying cause. However, there are some general symptoms that may indicate some kind of liver disease. These include: yellow skin and eyes, known as jaundice. dark urine, pale, bloody, or black stool. swollen ankles, legs, or abdomen. nausea.

Cirrhosis is when scar tissue replaces healthy liver tissue. This stops the liver from working normally. Cirrhosis is a long-term (chronic) liver disease. The damage to your liver builds up over time. The liver is your body's largest internal organ. It lies up under your ribs on the right side of your belly.

Signs and symptoms of liver disease include: Skin and eyes that appear yellowish (jaundice) Abdominal pain and swelling. Swelling in the legs and ankles. Itchy skin. Dark urine color. Pale stool color, or bloody or tar-colored stool. Chronic fatigue.

### Liver problems - Symptoms and causes - Mayo Clinic

When liver failure occurs as a result of cirrhosis, it usually means that the liver has been failing gradually for some time, possibly for years. This is called chronic liver failure or End-stage Liver Disease (ESLD). Chronic liver failure can also be caused by malnutrition. More rarely, liver failure can occur suddenly, in as little as 48 hours.

### The Stages of Liver Disease - American Liver Foundation

Chronic liver disease\* refers to disease of the liver which lasts over a period of six months. It consists of a wide range of liver pathologies which include inflammation (chronic hepatitis), liver cirrhosis, and hepatocellular carcinoma. The entire spectrum need not be experienced.
